



## **4<sup>th</sup> of July Fireworks Show Frequently Asked Questions**

### **What time will the gates open?**

Gates open at 6:30 PM

### **What time will the fireworks display begin and how long does it last?**

We anticipate the fireworks display to start at approximately 9:30 PM and last 15-20 minutes.

### **What is your seating policy? When can I set-up?**

Attendees for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July Fireworks Event may begin setting their blankets and/or chairs at **6:30PM**. Seating is on a first come first serve basis.

\*Out of courtesy and respect for others, please do not place objects in areas that may obstruct someone's view; low chairs are encouraged. Pedestrian walkways will be marked...please keep pathways clear.

### **What items are prohibited?**

The following items are **PROHIBITED** at this event:

Alcohol of any kind

Glass bottles

Hard shell coolers

Water projecting devices

Weapons of any kind, including pocket knives and silverware

Personal protection devices such as conducted electrical weapons, mace, and pepper spray

Projectiles such as footballs, frisbees, etc.

BBQs

Pets

Fireworks

NOTE: On site personnel may deem other items, not on this list, as prohibited if the general safety of patrons is at risk.

### **Are dogs allowed at this event?**

Pets are not allowed at Weber Point Event Center. It is expected to be very crowded and most dogs are likely to become agitated and scared by the enormity of the crowd and noise.

### **Can I bring food and/or drinks to this event?**

Yes, food and drinks are allowed, although, no hard shell coolers are permitted. For your enjoyment, there will also be food trucks and vendors on site that will be selling different types of foods to try.

### **Can I bring alcohol to this event?**

**No** alcohol will be permitted.

### **Is smoking allowed at the facility?**

There is **no** smoking allowed at Weber Point Event Center.

### **Is there an admission fee?**

No, it's FREE!

### **Are there trash and recycling bins?**

Portable recycling & trash receptacles are provided surrounding Weber Point for your convenience. In an effort to minimize the cleanup burden on parks personnel, please use designated waste receptacles.

**Are there restrooms at Weber Point?**

Restrooms with hand-washing facilities are available at Weber Point Event Center.

**Where is the best place to park?**

The Weber Point parking lot will **NOT** be opened for this event. We ask you use street and designated lots for your parking needs. For additional parking click on the downtown parking map at [www.stocktongov.com](http://www.stocktongov.com).

**Will there be security at this event?**

It is the City of Stockton's priority to make sure this is a safe event. Therefore, a private security company and the Stockton Police Department will be on site for the duration of the evening.

**Will the interactive fountain be on?**

Yes. The interactive fountain will run from 6:30 – 8:30 PM and monitors will on site to enforce safety rules.
