DIRECTIONS

From Interstate 5: Exit State Highway 4 eastbound to State Highway 99 northbound. Follow directions from State Highway 99.

From State Highway 99: Exit Linden-Highway 26/Fremont Street. Travel east on East Fremont Street/State Highway 26 for approximately 8.5 miles to the four-way stop at North Duncan Road. (Rinaldi's Market is on the northwest corner). Turn north (left) on North Duncan Road; turn east (right) on East Front Street. (Linden Elementary School is on the southeast corner.) De Vinci's Delicatessen and Catering is about one-half mile east, on the north (left) side of East Front Street. **You may park in the Holy Cross Catholic Church parking lot.** Thank you for **not parking** in front of DeVinci's, The Bean Plant Emporium, and The Primitive Barn. **Please respect the property of Linden residents; do not park on lawns or block driveways.**



PLEASE READ

ALL RIDERS MUST WEAR AN ANSI OR US CPSC APPROVED HELMET. **NO HELMET, NO RIDE.**

COURSE CLOSSES AT 3:00 P.M. RIDERS STILL ON THE COURSE WILL BE ASKED TO SAG TO THE FINISH. RIDERS WHO REFUSE WILL BE ON THEIR OWN TO COMPLETE THE RIDE.

THE ROUTES

Metric Century (65 miles, 1,300 feet of climbing):

The route leaves Linden and traverses the quiet back roads of San Joaquin, Stanislaus and Calaveras counties, including a portion of Stage Three of the 2011 Tour of California. The towns of Linden, Peters, Farmington, Eugene, Milton, Jenny Lind and Bellota await you; almond, apple, cherry, peach, pear, plum and walnut orchards, and vineyards abound. Three rest stops, including lunch, will provide fuel and hydration along the way.

Quarter Century (25 miles, 300 feet of climbing):

The route leaves Linden, then passes through the towns of Farmington and Peters in San Joaquin County. Apple, cherry, peach, pear, plum and walnut orchards, and vineyards abound. A fully stocked rest stop will provide fuel and hydration midway through the ride.

Fees include maps, route sheets, route markings, pre-ride tech support and spare tubes courtesy of **Performance Bicycle Shop #55**, radio communications thanks to the **Stockton-Delta Amateur Radio Club**, support and gear (SAG) vehicles, and awesome volunteers. Fully stocked rest stops provide fuel and hydration with snacks contributed by **Marin Cyclists Club**, **Quackcyclists**, and **Xe Dap Viet Cycling Club**, brownies prepared by the **San Joaquin Delta College Culinary Arts Program**, apple slices courtesy of **McDonald's of San Joaquin County**, Gatorade donated by **Farmington Circle K**, and precious water from **Ising's Culligan Water**. You'll enjoy a wonderful lunch midway through the ride, and a scrumptious post ride meal catered by **DeVinci's Delicatessen and Catering-Linden** with entertainment by **Creative Sounds DJ and Sound Services** at the finish. **Photo-Crazy, Inc.** will capture images of riders on the road, available for purchase after the event at www.photocrazy.com.
