

2018 Slurry Seal Project



California State Senate Bill 1 (SB 1) has funded the resurfacing of approximately 11 miles of local neighborhood streets at 75 locations in Stockton. Resurfacing will **start in fall 2018** and take about one month.

- Residents in neighborhoods where streets are being resurfaced will receive notices at least 72 hours before work starts.
- Notices will include information about access to homes, driveways and streets.
- Travelers will be rerouted during preparation, while work is occurring, and for at least two-hours after resurfacing.

- Please allow extra time for possible delays, watch for signs and workers in the area, use caution, and reduce speed.
- Please do not drive on oily roads that have not been opened to through traffic.
