 - COVID-related hospitalizations have decreased by 2.9% over the past week.

HOUSING & HOMELESSNESS

HOT Team (Homeless Outreach Team)

- **June 10, 2021** - 21 unsheltered individuals contacted
- Morelli Park; Highway 4 at Stanislaus Street (beneath Crosstown Freeway); Lafayette Square (Worth Street at Hunter Street).
- Stockton Fire, Stockton PD, SJC Behavioral Health, SJC General Hospital Clinics, St. Mary's Dining Hall, California Highway Patrol, Community Medical Center, Women's Center, SJC Veterans Services.
- Provided food, water, hygiene kits and State ID card vouchers at each location; Community Medical Center staff provided COVID-19 vaccines and screened persons for virus symptoms; Fire prevention and cooking safety information was shared with campers; Provided medical care.

Homeless Encampment Clean-ups

- **June 12, 2021** - Public Works & Police Department - Weber Ave. (Across from Morelli Park); Lincoln St. at WB SR 4 on-ramp; Lafayette St. & American St.; Washington St. & Stanislaus St.; California St. & Ninth St.
 - 15 truck loads were removed, totaling 27 tons
 - YTD: 565 truck loads have been removed, totaling 918 tons

City of Stockton Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP)

- Opened to applications March 15 (noon); application deadline extended until all funds are used: www.stocktonca.gov/renthelp
- **2,502** applications completed & submitted; **1,351** approved.
- **\$6,292,114** obligated to date.
- Assistance for low-income households, rent and utilities.
