  - 3,616,779 cases to-date; 2,667 cases today
  - 59,768 deaths to-date; 78 deaths today
  - Tests 57,733,460 to-date; 252,334 today
  - Vaccines administered: 25,533,215
- **State COVID-19 Rates - updated April 13, 2021**
  - Daily new cases (per 100K) - 4.8
  - Positivity rate - 1.8%
  - ICU statewide availability - 31.9%
- **State Blueprint for Safer Economy**
  - California has reached 4 million vaccinations
- **Updated April 2, 2021 - Activity & Business Tiers Table**

- **Eff. April 15, 2021** - Ages 16+ eligible

- As-of April 19, 2021 - 245,734 vaccinations administered: 84,834 partial (15.08%); 160,900 fully (28.59%)

**HOT Team (Homeless Outreach Team)**

- **April 15, 2021** - 29 unsheltered individuals contacted
- El Dorado & 8th Sts; Wilson Wy @ Mormon Slough; and Pilgrim & Jefferson Sts @ Mormon Slough
- Stockton Fire, Stockton PD, SJC Sheriff, SJC Probation, SJC Behavioral Health, St. Mary's Dining, Stockton Shelter, Stockton Community Kitchen, Healthcare for Homeless Veterans, Community Medical Center
- Food, backpacks, medical & COVID screening, ID card assistance, warming & cooking fire education, electrocution risks; reminded campers of encampment clean-up scheduled for April 17, 2021.

**Homeless Encampment Clean-ups**

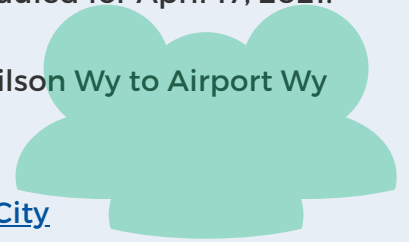
- **April 17, 2021** - Public Works & Police Department -Mormon Slough: Wilson Wy to Airport Wy
  - 28 Truckloads were remove, totaling 59 tons
  - YTD: 422 Truckloads have been removed, totaling 711 tons

- **April 17, 2021** - Community Drive-Thru Recycling Event held at Weston Ranch High School (Dist. 6)
  - 368 vehicles served; 10 vouchers provided for the Landfill

**City of Stockton Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP)**

- Opened to applications March 15 (noon); application deadline April 30 (5 p.m.)
- **506** applications completed & submitted; **2,066** applications in-progress
- **105** applications fully processed providing \$370,791 in rental arrears funding
  - Last week (April 12, 2021) - 471 submitted; 1,770 in-progress; 43 fully processed
