	Draft Climate Action Plan & Enhancements. The City completed a Climate Action Plan (CAP) & enhancements	

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that reduce GHG emissions consistent with AB 32, SB375 & Settlement Agreement with the CA Attorney General & Sierra Club; Tools & Strategies (e.g. CAP GHG Emissions Reduction Measures) to reduce GHG emissions have been drafted and is included into the Draft Revised CAP. Draft CAP was the focus of CAP Advisory Committee meeting in Oct. 2013. Administrative Draft Subsequent Environmental Impact Report (SEIR) has been completed and is being reviewed by City staff. Public release of the CAP SEIR is expected in the first quarter of 2014. A generalized City-wide assessment of the City's urban forest has been completed and an Urban Tree Planting Program has been included in the Draft CAP. This resource dependent plan would begin in 2016 and result in as many as 3,500 trees being planted. This program would reduce the GHG emissions by 75 Metric tons through active carbon sequestration by 2020. It is anticipated that the CAP and related plans/programs will be presented to City Council in the fourth quarter of 2014. Multi-Family Recycling - Reached out to multi-family units to gather data regarding their recycling activities, outreached to property managers on the value of the City's Recycling Program, and distributed recycling kits to residents living in Stockton
