GENERAL PLAN UPDATE COMMUNITY MEETINGS TO “ENVISION STOCKTON”

(Stockton, CA) – The City of Stockton is updating its General Plan, the plan that determines future development and growth of the city, through the year 2040. Extensive community involvement and participation is essential to the process called “Envision Stockton.” The new General Plan will serve as the City’s blueprint for future decisions regarding land use, community services, mobility, housing, and resource conservation.

An additional community workshop has been added at San Joaquin Delta College, for a total of three community workshops during the month of September. Everyone is welcome and encouraged to attend and participate. These meetings will cover the exact same information, which will introduce the project to the community and help define a long-term vision for Stockton.
