Wilson Way Road Closure for Emergency Bridge Repairs

(Stockton, CA) - The City of Stockton is temporarily closing all lanes of traffic on Wilson Way for emergency bridge repairs over Mormon Slough. Southbound traffic on Wilson Way will be detoured at Hazelton Avenue; northbound traffic will be detoured at Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd.

- Passenger cars are encouraged to use local adjacent roads as an alternate route; and
- Truck traffic should use Airport Way.

Motorists can expect congestion and delays on alternate routes due to this road closure.

The City of Stockton will be using changeable message signs to provide advance notification to motorists of traffic pattern changes associated with the work. The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
