DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT
(Pursuant to Public Resources Code Sections 21092 and 21092.3 and
Cal. Code of Regulations Title 14, Section 15087)

The City of Stockton Community Development Department has completed, independently reviewed and analyzed the following Environmental Impact Report:

Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR) SCH #2012102061 for the NorCal Logistics Center (P12-110). The Applicant proposes to further subdivide approximately 325 acres ("project site") of its property. The project site is comprised of two non-adjacent portions: an approximately 50-acre southern portion adjacent to Arch Road and an approximately 275-acre northern portion adjacent to Mariposa Road. The project site is located entirely within City limits and is zoned for industrial uses. The project includes subdivision of the 50-acre southern portion located along Arch Road into six (6) lots and subdivision of the approximately 275-acre northern portion located along Mariposa Road into fifteen (15) lots.
