## APPLICATION PROCESS

If the proposed non-stormwater discharge is determined to be contaminated and not allowed to be discharged into the municipal Stormwater system by City, State, or Federal regulations, the discharge may then be considered for wastewater system disposal, which is a separate application and review process.

### **The applicant is responsible for the following for Non-Stormwater Discharge to the Storm Drain System:**

1. Apply to the Regional Water Quality Control Board for a Low Threat General Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) permit, and provide City with copies of the Notice of Intent (NOI) and Notice of Applicability (NOA) from the Regional Water Quality Control Board to provide coverage under the Low Threat General Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR), including any and all analytical results or reports submitted to the State.
2. Complete the Application To Discharge Non-Stormwater to Storm Drain and Certification forms (Application) and submit to the Municipal Utilities Department.
3. The applicant is required to provide flow monitoring data to the City, unless specifically waived by the City. The waiver shall be in writing as shown at the bottom of the certification form that is part of the Application.
4. Payment of all applicable fees.
5. Compliance with all applicable City, State and Federal requirements for general discharge.

## STORM DRAIN DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

### **Non-Stormwater Discharge to Storm Drain System**

The undersigned agree to comply with all applicable requirements of the Stockton Municipal Code, specifically including, but not limited to, Section 13.16.060, the general discharge prohibition:

No person shall contribute or cause to be contributed, directly or indirectly, to the City storm drainage system any pollutant, wastewater, or any substance or material which will interfere with the operation or performance of the City storm drainage system or violate the City's NPDES permit. This general prohibition applies to all persons, and said persons are subject to applicable regulation under the Federal Stormwater Effluent Limitations Guidelines and any other Federal, State, or local standards, requirements, or regulations.

The above general discharge prohibition specifically references the City's NPDES permit. The permit as of October 2012 is Order No. R5-2007-0173, NPDES No. CAS083470, Waste Discharge Requirements, City of Stockton and County of San

Joaquin, Stormwater Discharges from Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System, San Joaquin County. This permit includes the following sections:

**A. Discharge Prohibitions – Stormwater Discharges**

1. Discharges from MS4s in a manner causing, or threatening to cause, a condition of pollution, contamination, or nuisance as defined in Section 13050 of the California Water Code are prohibited.
2. Discharges from MS4s, which cause or contribute to exceedances of water quality standards for surface water or ground water, are prohibited.
3. Discharges from MS4s containing pollutants, which have not been reduced to the MEP, are prohibited.

**B. Discharge Prohibitions – Non-Stormwater Discharges**

1. Each Permittee shall effectively prohibit all types of non-stormwater discharges into its MS4s unless such discharges are either authorized by a separate NPDES permit; or not prohibited in accordance with this Order.
2. Pursuant to 40 CFR 122.26(d)(2)(iv)(B)(1), the following categories of non-stormwater discharges need only be prohibited from entering a MS4 if such categories of discharges are identified as a source of pollutants to waters of the United States:
  - a. Diverted stream flows
  - b. Rising ground waters
  - c. Uncontaminated ground water infiltration as defined by 40 CFR 35.2005(20)
  - d. Uncontaminated pumped ground water
  - e. Foundation drains
  - f. Springs
  - g. Water from crawl space pumps
  - h. Footing drains
  - i. Air conditioning condensation
  - j. Flows from riparian habitats and wetlands
  - k. Water line and hydrant flushing
  - l. Landscape irrigation
  - m. Discharges from potable water sources other than water main breaks
  - n. Irrigation water
  - o. Individual residential car washing
  - p. De-chlorinated swimming pool discharges
  - q. Lawn watering
  - r. Street wash water

**CERTIFICATION**

I certify that the non-stormwater discharge for which this document applies will comply with the Stockton Municipal Code. I am personally qualified to make this certification or I have consulted with a qualified professional who is qualified to make this certification. I am a duly authorized representative of the discharger.

The discharger shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the City of Stockton, its officers, officials, employees and volunteers; from and against all liability, claim, damages, losses and expenses, including, but not limited to, attorney fees arising in whole or in part from any act or omission of the discharger related to the discharge.

The discharger understands and accepts that when repair and/or replacement of storm drain piping or appurtenances occurs the discharge may need to cease during the time of repair or replacement. The discharger agrees to cease discharge, for any period of time or for any reason, when requested by the City. The City will provide as much advance notice as practical.
