DRIVE-THRU RECYCLING EVENTS

There are **6** drive-thru recycling and compost giveaway events annually. These events provide no-cost recycling and disposal services to our residential customers. On-site confidential paper shredding and compost bag distribution are special services also available at these events.

COMMUNITY CLEANUP AND BEAUTIFICATION

The City of Stockton, together with numerous volunteer groups, focused on performing beautification projects and litter abatement in City parks.

Volunteer-led community cleanups and beautification events continue thanks to current and new partnerships within our community. In 2023, new partnerships were developed with Kiwanis Club of Stockton, the University of the Pacific, and ASM Global.

The Stockton Police Department's Neighborhood Services Section (NSS) worked with various communities to take proactive steps to improve quality of life by enforcing the removal of garbage and blight, working to reduce crime, and increasing the sense of safety.

The Neighborhood Betterment Team (NBT) is a two per year, 90-day program that includes a large-scale neighborhood cleanup day. Similarly, Code Enforcement Sweeps focus on blight, have a shorter duration, and provide a neighborhood cleanup day. The Police Department, together with Waste Management and Republic Services, hosted 5 Neighborhood Cleanup events at various locations citywide.
