I, Reed Hogan, declare:	
	I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth in this declaration and, if called as
a witness, I could and would testify competently to these facts under oath.	
	2. I was born on August 21, 1949 and am 62 years old. I live at 7756 South Oak
Way, Sacramento, California 95831.	
	3. I was hired by the City of Stockton on January of 1995 and retired on June 30,
	2011 as a Senior Civil Engineer.
	4. My spouse is my dependent on the City's Medical Plan and I will be eligible for
	Medicare when I reach the age of 65.
	5. My net PERS retirement check is \$3,284.00. My net income for the tax year 2012
	after taxes is estimated to be \$58,858.00.
	6. I am informed and believe the City has adopted a monthly premium for retiree
	health benefits. If required to pay this premium to receive City Health Plan benefits, even
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Case No. 12-32118 Adv. No. \_\_\_\_ with the \$150 subsidy for one year, it would be \$1,426.66 per month, or \$17,119.92 annually. That would amount to 29% of my entire net income, a blow that would impact us severely.

7. I have a thyroid condition and very high cholesterol which require regular monitoring. My wife has a thyroid condition which requires regular monitor by a medical specialist. Both of these medical conditions require expensive medications on a regular basis. Attempting to obtain other insurance for these pre-existing conditions will be very expensive if we could even get such coverage.
