- **Eff. April 1** - Age 50+ eligible; **Eff. April 15** - Opening eligibility to age 16+
- To be notified, register at MyTurn.CA.gov
- 195,915 vaccinations administered: 83,755 partial; 112,160 fully (as-of April 5, 2021)
- **Eff. April 7** - Kaiser Permanente Mass Vaccination opens at Stockton Arena for Kaiser members and the public; **vaccinations by appointment only** - schedule appointments through MyTurn.CA.gov

HOUSING & HOMELESSNESS

HOT Team (Homeless Outreach Team)

- April 1, 2021 - 40 unsheltered individuals contacted
- Lincoln St/Weber Ave; Mormon Slough west of DMV; Calaveras River from El Dorado St to West Ln
- Stockton Fire, Stockton PD, SJC Behavioral Health, St. Mary's Dining, Salvation Army, Community Medical Center
- Notified those in the DMV area of upcoming clean-up & need to move; noted fewer encampments in the Mormon Slough area.
- Food, water, hygiene kits & resources info, COVID screening, warming & cooking fire education; one person eligible and referred to Room Key.



City of Stockton Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP)

- Opened to applications March 15 (noon); application deadline April 30 (5 p.m.)
- **384** applications completed & submitted; **1,588** applications in-progress; 9 applications fully processed providing \$22K in rental arrears funding
 - Last week (March 29, 2021) - 287 submitted; 1,324 in-progress
