 - 3,643,992 cases to-date; 1,512 cases today
 - 60,763 deaths to-date; 15 deaths today
 - Tests 60,709,771 to-date; 194,834 today
 - Vaccines administered: 30,501,771
- **State COVID-19 Rates - updated April 27, 2021**
 - Daily new cases (per 100K) - 4.7
 - Positivity rate - 1.5%
 - ICU statewide availability - 31.3%

HOUSING & HOMELESSNESS

HOT Team (Homeless Outreach Team)

- **April 29, 2021** - 33 unsheltered individuals contacted
- Anderson St. @ I-5; I-5 east frontage between MLK Jr. Blvd. & Eighth St.; I-5 @ Monte Diablo Ave.; I-5 @ March Ln.
- Stockton Fire, Stockton PD, SJC Behavioral Health, Community Medical Center
- Food, water, resource information, fire safety & prevention education with focus on grass fire prevention.
- COVID-19 screening - no COVID-19 signs or symptoms - Community Medical is working on a plan to provide vaccinations during future outreach activities.

Homeless Encampment Clean-ups

- **May 1, 2021** - Public Works & Police Department - Anderson St. under I-5. plus trash piles along Mormon Slough
 - 17 truck loads were removed, totaling 28 tons
 - YTD: 494 truck loads have been removed, totaling 808 tons

City of Stockton Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP)

- Opened to applications March 15 (noon); application deadline extended on April 30.
- **626** applications completed & submitted; **2,616** applications in-progress
- **260** applications fully processed providing \$923,329 in rental arrears funding
 - Last week (April 19, 2021) - 539 submitted; 2,255 in-progress; fully processed
