SESP Eligibility Requirements:

1	Program begins for all permits applied for after January 19, 2016.
2	The applicant must start construction within 6 months of permit issuance
3	The Building Industry Association is working with the NAACP and other community organizations to facilitate the inclusion of disadvantaged communities.
4	50% of the workforce used to complete the work of the permit must be residents of Stockton.
5	Quarterly Reporting of 50% Local Workforce: Applicants must provide a list of all employees with addresses and have 30 days to correct a deficiency of under 50% Stockton local hires. See form of Quarterly Reporting of Local Workforce Requirement.
6	Failure to adhere to SESP Eligibility Requirements will lead to exclusion from program and reimbursement of the reduced fee amounts during the non-compliant period.
7	Applicants not participating in SESP program will be charged non-SESP fee rates.
